Package 2: *Half day Countryside & Batu Caves Tour*

A trip to the outskirts along "Ambassador's Row", Istana Sharif Ali, Malay Villages. Our first stop at the Royal Selangor Pewter will feature one of the largest and most well known pewter factory in the world, reputed for its high quality and craftsmanship. You will be shown the different processes, such as casting, filing, polishing, soldering, hammering and engraving during this factory tour. Next we stop at a Batik Factory and see how Batik is designed and printed. Our last stop will be at the limestone hills of Batu Caves that comprises of three caverns and several small caves. It is the shrine of Lord Murugah or also known as Lord Subramaniam, a Hindu deity. A flight of 272 steps lead up to the temple cave. Another cave at the bottom of the hill showcases a gallery filled with crafted images of deities and murals depicting scenes from the Hindu Scriptures

CHENG HOON TENG - Built 1645-oldest know Chinese Temple in the peninsula.

CHRISTCHURCH - Built 1753- A well preserved example of Dutch masonry.

OTHERS - Portuguese Settlement, St. Peter's Church, Sultans Well, Malacca Museum, Jonker Street and Bukit China.

Putrajaya, Malaysia's Smart City - in a Garden, is located in the heart of the country's highly vaunted Multimedia Super Corridor (MSC) and is the Malaysian Governments impressive new administrative seat. The landmark complex stretches over 11,320 acres and is situated 25km from Kuala Lumpur.

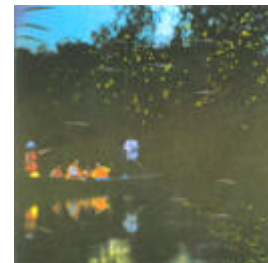

Package 6: Full day Fireflies and Kuala Selangor

HIGHLIGHTS:

Kampung Kuantan/Fort Altinsburg/Silvered-leaf monkeys

The journey from Kuala Lumpur takes about an hour through small towns and scenic countryside. On arrival at Kuala Selangor, visit "Kota Melawati" formerly known as "Fort Altinsburg", the execution block, royal mausoleum and colonial buildings. The hill offers a panoramic view Selangor coast and the Malacca straits. A bird sanctuary park at the foot of Bukit Melawati is an ideal place for bird-watchers to watch local any migratory birds. Also found are silvered-leaf monkeys, butterflies and etc. We will then stop at a riverside seafood restaurant where you will enjoy a seafood dinner at the riverside restaurant while watching the a river view sunset. We then proceed to Kampung Kuantan for the highlight of the tour. We will be rowed upstream in a small unmotorised boat (tongkang) in the quiet darkness to witness the blinking trees. This scintillating display of fireflies portrays an image of a flashing Christmas tree. The synchronized, rhythmic flashing is produced by the thousands of fireflies found in the mangrove swamp of Kampung Kuantan. The skilled local oarsmen make this experience a memorable and an unforgettable one.

Package 7: Full day Aborigine Settlement & Elephant Sanctuary

HIGHLIGHTS:

Feeding the elephant/Bathing the elephants/Aborigine settlement.

Kuala Gandah Elephant Sanctuary was established in 1967 by the Department of Wildlife and National Parks. The centre is a base for the Elephant Relocation Team, which began the elephant translocation program in 1974. The only one of its kind in Malaysia, it is dedicated in relocating wild elephants from their habitat areas which are constantly being encroached upon by plantations to other suitable and protected habitats throughout peninsula Malaysia such as Taman Negara. Over the past 25 years the centre has helped prevent further decline of the elephant population by relocating more than 300 wild elephants.

Package 8: Full day Genting Highlands Tour

Amidst the freshness of cool, crisp mountain air about 6000 feet above sea level lies Malaysia's only casino resort. Upon reaching the Highlands, you can try your luck at Blackjack, Keno, Roulette or a host of other casino games. If this is not your cup of tea, then, take time off to enjoy the numerous recreational facilities at the indoor and the outdoor theme park. There is the Corkscrew, Euro Express Roller Coaster, Turbo Drop, Super Tabanggan & Sky Venture – the only sky diving simulator in Asia

PENANG

The capital city, Georgetown, is a quaint picture from the past with narrow streets, trishaws, temples, colonial buildings and street traders plying their goods.

Explore the myriad of intriguing tourist attractions such as the Botanical Gardens, Kek Lok Si, Snake Temple and many more. Or refresh yourself amidst Penang Hill's cool surroundings.

For those seeking some beach sun and fun, there is the popular Batu Ferringhi Beach.

LANGKAWI

The Langkawi archipelago is a cluster of 99 islands just off the coast of Kedah, close to Perlis and just south of Thailand. Pulau Langkawi, noted for its legends and beautiful views, is the most developed in the group. It has good beaches, abundant marine life and offers an idyllic retreat from the urban jungle. A duty-free port, this island of scenic, tranquil landscapes, has become a favorite destination for local and international visitors alike. Mainly a padi-growing and fishing region, Pulau Langkawi's residents have diversified into more commercial and tourism-related activities. The main commercial areas are in the towns of Kuah, Padang Maksirat and Padang Lalang. The island of Langkawi is steeped in legend and there are some fascinating stories connected to several tourist attractions.
